

## **How are we encouraging social distancing and a safe camp environment?**

All camps will be following the recommendations of the CDC and ACA which include:

- Camps will be limited to 12 students per class in order to ensure space between students
- Restrict mixing between groups of students
- Limiting nonessential visitors and volunteers
- Keep each child's belongings separated from others'
- Ensure adequate supplies to minimize sharing of high-touch materials as much as possible
- Limit use of supplies and equipment by one group of children at a time and clean and disinfect between use.
- Restrooms and other surfaces children regularly contact shall be sanitized with a disinfectant effective against coronavirus on a regular schedule and between groups occupying a particular area.

## **What is the STAR Rep doing to reduce the spread of germs?**

In order to do so we will be abiding by our consistent procedures recommended by the CDC to prevent the spread of colds and flus daily.

- Ensuring hand washing supplies are well stocked and accessible for camp participants, staff and volunteers
- Increasing hand sanitizer dispenser stations placed throughout the STAR Rep Building. Every camper must sanitize before they enter, and after they leave the STAR Rep Building
- Taking every camper, staff and volunteer's temperature with a non-touch thermometer
- Increasing the frequency of disinfecting sprays/wipes to sanitize frequently touched surfaces (doorknobs, light switches, bathrooms, chairs, tables, etc.)
